

In 2022, the Kodiak Rodeo and State Fair Board of Directors spear headed a variety of improvement projects to support the mission of KRSF. Thanks to The Rasmussen Foundation, Friends of the Kodiak Fair and Rodeo received a grant to update the ageing bathrooms on site. The community garden plot also received an overhaul with the support of a grant from RurAL CAP's GROW program. Sporting new raised beds, improved ground, composting stations, and fencing we welcome growers from the community. The Board of Directors continues to look at different capital improvements that would provide the most benefit to the community. All projects that are undertaken are vetted based on their relevance to community benefit.

In 2023, we are looking forward to working with Rodeo Alaska once again and producing a large rodeo and fair geared towards bringing statewide contestants and community spectators. We will continue to offer the fairgrounds space in support of local non-profit events and for rent. We will continue the long-standing horse boarding services as well. We are working hard to create a space where we can gather with our friends and neighbors, and none of this can be done without the generous support of our sponsors.
